2 09-11-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for
offences punishable under Section 414 of the I.P.C. and Section
30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 60 litres
Nepali liquor was recovered from two gunny bags kept on the
motorcycle which was being driven by the petitioner. Petitioner
claims that he is having clean antecedent and is in custody since
27.08.2017.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of
the case, the abovenamed petitioner is directed to be released
on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten



Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.D.J. II, Supaul in connection with S.T. Excise Case No. 795/17 arising out of Balua Bazar P. S. Case No.56/17.

Further, if the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found to be involved in similar nature of case then the court concerned would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bond.
