ORAL ORDER

- 5 01-07-2017 Keeping in view the order passed by the Municipal Corporation, Gaya, as is evident from Annexure-A dated 15.06.2017, declining the claim of the petitioner and indicating that a sum of Rs.4,22,805/- is yet to be recovered from the petitioner, no case is made out for proceeding further in the matter as the direction was issued by the Writ Court that the petitioner should file an application before respondent No.3 , satisfy the respondent No.3 and the respondent No.3 after examining the claim made may pass an appropriate order. Respondent No.3 having passed the order, Annexure-A, as is



indicated hereinabove, now in this contempt proceedings, no further action is required to be taken. In case, the petitioner is aggrieved by the order, liberty shall be available to challenge the same in accordance with law.

With the aforesaid, the application stands disposed of.
