2 15-11-2017 The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with

Shakurabad P.S. Case No. 49 of 2017, registered for offences

punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 337, 447, 504

and 302 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner and others is of assault

to the deceased causing his death.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that only

allegation against the petitioner that he along with other co-

accused persons were involved in brick batting and specific

allegation of assault on the deceased against other three accused

persons. Further petitioner has no criminal antecedent and has

been in judicial custody since 11.07.2017.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, let

the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail



bonds of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Jehanabad, in connection with Shakurabad P.S. Case No. 49 of 2017, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.
