2 19-12-2017 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner, already in custody, seeks bail in connection with Chakia P.S.Case No. 202 of 2017 registered under Sections 25(1-b)a/26 of the Arms Act.

Allegation in brief is that police recovered a country made pistol as well as two live cartridges from possession of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case, the police has submitted charge sheet in the matter however charge has not been framed and the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he has been in custody since 21.07.2017.

Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances,



the petitioner, namely, Bikal Kumar Singh @ Chhote Singh @ Chhotu Singh, is directed to be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Chakia P.S. Case No. 202 of 2017, with condition that one of the bailors must be his close family relative. Petitioner shall remain physically present on each and every date during trial and in case of failure on two consecutive dates without any medical urgency, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled.
