3 03-02-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Nauhatta P.S. Case No. 12 of 2011 registered under Sections 409,
420 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is that the informant opened savings
account in Madhya Bihar Gramin Bank, Nauhatta, bearing A/C No.
6896, in which, Rs.2,35,000/- was in balanced but the cheque book
not issued to her. The Manager of the Bank issued the cheques
illegally in her name and two cheques, one Rs.23,500 and another
Rs. 1,92,000/- were issued in her fake signature in the name of this
petitioner and said amount debited to her account.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this



petitioner had given cash of Rs.2,50,000/- to Rita Ekka, wife of Jonson Ekka of Bariyatu but she could not manage to return the same and thereafter she handed over two cheques, one Rs.23,500 and another Rs. 1,92,000/- m were given to her in respect to account of informant and the petitioner deposited the both cheque in his account and the amount was also credited. Rita Ekka, in paragraph 117 of the case diary, has admitted the said facts and also disclosed that both cheques were taken by her from the informant for providing her job. It is further submitted that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the J.M. Ist Class, Dehri, Rohtas, in connection with Nauhatta P.S. Case No. 12 of 2011, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
