2 23-11-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for
offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 38 and 47 of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 15 litres
Mahua wine was recovered from the house of the petitioner.
Petitioner claims that she is having clean antecedent and is in
custody since 21.10.2017.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of
the case, the abovenamed petitioner is directed to be released
on bail on her furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten
Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the



satisfaction of the Special Judge, Excise, Gaya in connection with Barachatti P.S. Case No. 659/17.

Further, if the petitioner, after her release in this case, is again found to be involved in similar nature of case then the court concerned would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of her bail bond.
