2 18-12-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted under
Sections 272, 273, 290 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 47,
47(A), 48(II), 51 and 57 of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act,
2016.

It is alleged that 21.75 litres of liquor is recovered from
the joint house of the petitioner.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner is in custody since 18.09.2017. The petitioner has got
no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of
witnesses alleged against the petitioner. It is alleged that 21.75
litres of wine is recovered from the joint house of the petitioner.



Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner had no knowledge regarding the alleged incident. There is no compliance of section 100 of the Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the state, it has been submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Muzaffarpur, in connection with Hathauri P.S. Case No. 101/2016.
