are being reproduced hereinbelow :-

‘18.07.2017 – It has been submitted at the Bar that Mr.

Sameer Ranjan, learned counsel for the appellants is suffering

from viral fever.

Put up this matter after one week as a matter of last



indulgence to the appellants.

02.08.2017 :- Nobody appears on behalf of the appellant in spite of repeated calls for hearing under Order 41 Rule 11 CPC.

It transpires that this matter was earlier also adjourned on the prayer on behalf of the appellants.

Put up this matter tomorrow, by way of last indulgence to the appellants.

07.08.2017 :- As prayed for on behalf of the appellant, put up this matter after a week.
