learned counsel for the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with
Siwam Town P.S. Case No. 667 of 2016 registered under
Section 304(B)/34 of the I.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners are in-laws of the deceased and have been falsely
implicated in the present case. The allegation of demand of
motorcycle is against the husband who is already in custody and
relation of the deceased, with her in-laws, was good and there
was no grievance against them. In fact the deceased has
committed suicide.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Siwan in connection with Siwan Town P.S. Case No.667 of 2016 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
