learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with
Singhwara P.S. Case No. 165 of 2016 registered under Sections
147,148,149,153,153A,188,341,342,323,435,427,337,338,307,353
and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely
implicated in the present case. Neither specific allegation has been
leveled against them nor has anyone sustained injury.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the
case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the
event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within
