It is conceded by the learned counsel for the petitioner that during pendency of the writ application the grievances of the petitioner in respect of post-retiral dues have already been redressed. However, he contended that certain arrear



of salary is still due to be paid to the petitioner.

In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ application is disposed of.

Since the roster of salary matter is not assigned to this Bench, the question in respect of non-payment of arrear of salary is left open. The petitioner would be at liberty to file a separate writ application in that regard before this Court.
