Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 366(A)/34 of
the Indian Penal Code.

The FIR relates to missing of Puja Kumari, the
daughter of the informant. The petitioner is under suspicion along
with others to have kidnapped her.

The victim-girl, in her statement under Section 164
Cr.P.C., stated that she had love-affairs with the petitioner, hence,
she has voluntarily gone with the petitioner.

Considering the statement of the victim-girl, let the
petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender
before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date



of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-VI, Gaya/Successor Court in connection with Tekari Police Station Case No. 218 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
