ORAL ORDER

2 29-03-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 06 of 2017 registered under Sections 498A/406/504/34 of the Indian Penal Code ¾ of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner. No specific allegation of overt act has been attributed against the petitioner. Further submission is that earlier Matrimonial Case had also been filed by the petitioner for dissolution of the marriage, which is pending in the Family Court.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the



case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the S.D.J.M., Bhojpur at Arrah in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 06 of 2017, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
