challenged the appointment of Respondent No. 5 in the  
  
Collectorate only because she, at some point of time, used to work  
  
as his Clerk. The writ court has found that this is the method of  
  
harassment adopted by the appellant and dismissed the writ  
  
petition with cost of Rs. 5000/-.

Keeping in view the reasons that weighed the Writ  
  
Court in dismissing the writ petition, we find no ground to



interfere into the matter.

In view the facts and circumstances, the order of the Writ Court imposing cost is set aside. However, the appellant is warned to be careful in future.

The appeal stands dismissed.
