2 24-05-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection
with Complaint Case No. 1360 (C) of 2016 for the offences
instituted under Sections 324, 406, 498A of the Indian Penal Code
and Section 3/4 of D.P. Act.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he along
with his family members used to torture the complainant for non-
fulfillment of the demand of Rs. 10 lac as dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The



petitioner has admitted that reconciliation between the parties has already been failed and divorce petition has also been filed by his wife in the court below. The petitioner has further relied upon the judgment of this court in the case of ***Md. Naimul Haque Ansari @ Naimul Haque Ansari & Ors Vs. The State of Bihar, reported in 2006(3) PLJR 182.***

On behalf of the State and counsel for the Opposite Party No.2, it has been submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named be released on anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today in connection with Complaint Case No. 1360 (C) of 2016 on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Patna subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
