3 13-07-2017 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail,
arises out of Complaint Case No. 129 of 2016, disclosing
offences under Sections 498A/323/504 of the Indian Penal
Code and Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Considering the nature of accusation and facts
and circumstances of the case, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, Vishnu Kumar, in the event of
his arrest or surrender before the Court below within six
weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.
10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like



amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Daudnagar, Aurangabad, in connection with Complaint Case No. 129 of 2016, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioner shall present himself before the Court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on his part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled.
