and the State.

This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail  
for offence under Sections 365 and 366/34 of the Indian  
Penal Code.

The first information report was lodged on  
missing of Anjali Kumari. The petitioner and others are  
under suspicion. The victim-girl, in her statement under  
Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code, stated that  
she had love affairs with the petitioner, as such, on the  
request of the petitioner she had gone along with the  
petitioner. However, the petitioner did nothing.

Considering the statement of the victim-girl,  
the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or  
surrender, within four weeks from the date of receipt of  
this order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing  
bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two



sureties of the like amount each in connection with **Katihar Town P.S. Case No. 756 of 2016** to the satisfaction of the **Chief Judicial Magistrate, Katihar**, or successor Court, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code.
