The half baked pleadings and half baked submissions can not form basis for any kind of relief or interference. The learned Single Judge had dismissed the Writ Application giving leeway to the appellants to approach the competent authority. They are free to establish the factum before them.

This Court will not adjudicate the issue in the summary proceeding, that too, with regard to acquisition made way back in the year 1984, for which the issue was already raised earlier without



success, which is evident from Annexure-2 to the Writ Application.

Appeal is dismissed.
