The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 447, 341, 323, 379 and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Only non-bailable allegation is under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code which is not made out against the petitioners. There is a case and counter case.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt



of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Judge-VII-cum-A.C.J.M., Patna/Successor Court in connection with Kadamkuan P.S. Case No.443 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
