2 08-03-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

By earlier order dated 28.09.2016, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 42818 of 2016 petitioner was directed to deposit 50% of Rs. 64,57,545/- within a period of four months from the date of the order.

It has been submitted that the petitioner has managed to deposit Rs. 15 lakhs on 09.09.2016 and Rs. 7 lakhs on 10th of February, 2017, but a further sum of Rs. 10 lakhs is yet to be deposited, for which he seeks extension of time.

Let petitioner deposit the rest 50% of Rs. 64,57,545/- within a period of four months from today and to that extent the order dated 28.09.2016, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 42818



of 2016 in connection with Araria P.S. Case No. 146/16, pending in the court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Araria is modified.

Modification application is, accordingly, allowed.
