2 16-03-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420 and 406
of the Indian Penal Code.

The N.G.O. had made complaint that the petitioner
was demanding Rs.1500/- on behalf of the local Mukhiya for grant
of incentive for construction of Sauchalay.

Submission of the petitioner is that he is not a man of
Mukhiya and he has been falsely implicated on suspicion.

Considering the nature of allegation, let the
petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender
before the court below within a period of thirty days from the date



of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Vaishali at Hajipur/successor court in connection with Bidupur P.S. case no. 327 of 2016 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
