learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is apprehending her arrest in connection with Ishipur Barahat P.S. Case No.66 of 2016 for allegedly having committed the offence under Section 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is the elder sister-in-law of the deceased, who was found dead in a well. It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case on the basis of mere suspicion. It is further submitted that the son of the informant died due to an accident and there is nothing on the record to show any enmity between the parties.

Considering the fact that the entire allegation is



based on speculation and mere suspicion, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur, in connection with Ishipur Barahat P.S. Case No.66 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
