ORAL ORDER

4 22-09-2017 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners, informant and the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Uchakagaon P.S. Case No. 23 of 2017 registered for the offence punishable under section 307 and other sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that there is case and counter case between the parties on account of admitted land dispute. Both sides sustained injuries.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions of advanced on behalf of the parties, let the



petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate IX, Gopalganj in connection with Uchakagaon P.S. Case No. 23 of 2017 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
