The petitioner shall file an appeal within a period of thirty days from the date of the order and the same shall be disposed of within the statutory period, in accordance with law.

The petitioner will be at liberty to file separate application for grant of any interim relief, if so advised, during the pendency of the appeal, within a period of ten days from the date of filing of the appeal.
