2 13-07-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in Danapur P.S.

Case no. 719 of 2015 for the offences registered under Section 414
of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that unknown accused persons were
loading theft cow on a pick-up van of which the petitioner is the
owner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and is not related with
the offence of which allegation has been made by the informant.
Informant is a Sub Inspector of Police and on whose statement the
present FIR has been lodged and the case is being investigated.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the present
case, let petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or



surrender within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Danapur, Patna, in Danapur P.S. Case no. 719 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
