ORAL ORDER

2 22-09-2017 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Mohania P.S.Case N0. 356 of 2016, disclosing offences under Sections 420,423,467,468,471/34,341,323 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is son of the informant. It is alleged against him that he executed the sale deed in favour of other co-accused persons showing the informant, i.e his father as dead.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that other co-accused persons playing fraud with the petitioner got said sale deed executed in their favour. The persons in whose favour, the sale deed has been executed have been granted anticipatory bail by this Court by order, dated 19.02.2016 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 49230 of 2016.



Considering the nature of dispute and the submission as above, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioner above named in the event of his arrest/surrender within six weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhabhua, Kaimur in Mohania P.S. Case No. 356 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioner shall present himself before the Police/Court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on his part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, his bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
