3 09-11-2017 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises
out of Complaint Case No. 127 of 2016, disclosing offences
under Sections 323, 342, 354, 386, 406, 420 and 468 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted
that the parties have settled their dispute by process of mediation
vide Mediation Proceeding No. 876 of 2017 before the Patna
High Court Mediation & Reconciliation Centre, Patna. Hence,
the petitioner deserves the privilege of anticipatory bail.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya, in connection with Complaint Case No. 127 of 2016, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
