9 15-11-2017 It has been submitted that both parties have now
performed marriage and living separately.

Learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 has
appeared and submitted that the petitioner is not appearing in the
court below even after issuance of N.B.W. He has further
submitted that there was order passed by this Court dated
18.03.2016 to deposit Rs. 750/- per month by the petitioner in the
court below, but the same has not been complied by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for opposite party no. 3 has
submitted that she has performed second marriage and living with
her husband.



In such circumstances, this criminal miscellaneous is disposed of with direction to both parties to appear in the court below and file necessary petition stating the fact that both have performed marriage and living separately. In such circumstances, the court below shall pass appropriate order in accordance with law after hearing both the parties.
