

Arising Out of PS.Case No. -284 Year- 2016 Thana -PATNA GRP CASE District- PATNA

The accusation is that while informant was at the parking place of Rajendra Nagar Junction then his mobile was stolen by unknown. In course of investigation, the mobile of the informant was found from the house of the petitioner, which is apparent from the order dated 29.04.2017 passed in A.B.P. No. 8153 of 2017 of Addl. Sessions Judge-III, Patna by which the anticipatory bail of the petitioner was rejected.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of allegation against the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, his prayer for grant of anticipatory bail stands rejected. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within six weeks and pray for regular bail, which would be considered by the trial Court in accordance with law without being prejudiced by the order of this Court.
