Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned

APP for the State as well as counsel for the Informant.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in **Kajraili P.S.**

Case No.24 of 2017 instituted for the offence under Section(s)

364/34 Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that mere suspicion has been raised against the petitioners, who are ladies.

Counsel for the petitioners has further submitted that victim, Soni

Kumari, is daughter of Petitioner No.1. She was married to elder

brother of the Informant. The victim girl after marriage was

living in the house of in-laws and the in-laws are responsible to

take care of the victim. Husband of the Petitioner No.1 had

earlier lodged Kajraili P.S. Case No.40 of 2016 against the

brother of the Informant and others for kidnapping of his



daughter, Soni Kumari, for the purpose of marriage.

Counsel for the Informant as well as learned APP have opposed the prayer for bail.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail is allowed. In the event of surrender/arrest of the petitioners, named above, within six weeks from today in connection with **Kajraili P.S. Case No.24 of 2017**, they shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, XIV, Bhagalpur**, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C. with further conditions: (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will automatically cancel bail bond of the petitioners and (3) if petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioners.
