This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Complaint Case No. 318/2012, disclosing offences under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 138 of the N.I. Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, taking a line of least resistance, has submitted that the petitioner is ready to pay the cheque amount of Rs. 30,000/- to the informant within four weeks from today before the court below and submit a receipt in token thereof.



If that is done and the petitioner surrenders before the court below within six weeks from today, the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rohtas at Sasaram** in connection with Complaint **Case No. 318/2012**, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

It is made clear that payment of said amount of Rs. 30,000/- will be subject to final adjudication.
