Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner apprehends arrest in Nabinagar P.S. Case No.
144 of 2017 instituted for the offence under Sections-304(B)/34 of the
Indian Penal Code and 34 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

Petitioner is husband of the deceased. There is allegation
against this petitioner that he used to commit torture with the daughter
of the informant for demand of dowry. It is further alleged that the
petitioner had illicit relationship with one Puja Kumari and he wanted
to marry with that girl. The daughter of the informant has been
murdered by this petitioner in the railway quarters.

Counsel for opposite party No. 2 has appeared and
submitted that there is direct allegation against this petitioner and
witnesses in paragraphs- 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12 have also supported the case
and also the factum of illicit relationship of the petitioner with another



girl.

In such circumstances, this court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected.

The petitioner is directed to surrender in the court below and seek regular bail which will be considered on its own merit without being prejudiced by this order.
