counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Bhagwanganj P.S. Case No. 06/2017 for allegedly having committed the offence under Sections 304 (B) of the Indian Penal Code and 3/4 of the Dowry Act.

In view of the fact that the petitioners are not family members and there is no specific role attributed to them in the FIR, let, the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be



released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Masaurhi, in connection with Bhagwanganjs P.S. Case No. 06/2017 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
