APP for the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in **Pachrukhi (Sarai) P.S. Case No.138 of 2017** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 341, 323, 324, 307, 504/34 Indian Penal Code.

It has been submitted that there is specific allegation against co-accused of assaulting father of the Informant on head by sharp cutting weapon.

From the written report, it appears that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner. There is case and counter case and the instant case is counter blast of Pachrukhi P.S. Case No.132 of 2017 instituted by petitioner no.1 against the prosecution party.



In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail is allowed. In the event of surrender/arrest of the petitioners, named above, within six weeks from today in connection with **Pachrukhi (Sarai) P.S. Case No.138 of 2017**, they shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Chief Judicial Magistrate, Siwan**, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C. with further conditions: (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will automatically cancel bail bond of the petitioners and (3) if petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioners.
