ORAL ORDER

2. 18-10-2017 Heard Sri Ashok Kumar, learned counsel assisted by
Dr. Bidhu Ranjan, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Addl. Public Prosecutor.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that in
the present case, only about 4 liters of country-made liquor was
shown to be recovered, which was hanging on the mudguard of
the petitioner's motorcycle.

After some argument, learned counsel for the
petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this petition so that
petitioner may appear before the court below and pray for
regular bail.

The prayer is allowed.

The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with an



observation that if within a period of six weeks from today the petitioner appears before the court below and makes a prayer for regular bail, the learned court below, without being prejudiced with this order, may examine the same and pass appropriate order in accordance with law, preferably; on the same date.
