Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner apprehends arrest in Cheriya Bariyarpur (Manjhaul) P.S. Case No. 81 of 2017 instituted for the offence under Sections 7 of the Essential Commodities Act.

As per the written report, the villagers apprehended one person with 65 litres of kerosene oil near Putakalaya Chowk and handed him over to the police, who disclosed his name as Sudhir Poddar. He disclosed before the police that he had purchased the same from kirana shop of Ram Kumar Choudhary at Pustakalaya Chowk. Further, it is informed by the villagers to the police that the recovered kerosene oil from the apprehended person is purchased from P.D.S. dealer.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that as per the written report, the name of the petitioner has been taken by



the general villagers. It is mentioned in para 3 to this petition that the petitioner has clean antecedent.

In such circumstances, prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed and it is ordered that the petitioner, named above, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court below within six weeks from the date of receipt/production of copy of this order, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount in connection with Cheriya Bariyarpur (Manjhaul) P.S. Case No. 81 of 2017 to the satisfaction of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Manjhaul, Begusarai subject to condition as laid down u/S 438 (2) of the Cr. P.C. with further conditions (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioner shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason, will automatically cancel bail bonds of the petitioner and (3) if the petitioner tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
