Heard Sri Pancham Lal Jaiswal, learned counsel for
the petitioners.

In the present restoration petition, an Interlocutory
Application vide I.A. No.3369 of 2016 has been filed for



substituting legal heirs of petitioner no.1, who died on 26.12.2005.

The main petition i.e. M.J.C. No.1641 of 2016 was filed on 21.04.2016 with a prayer to restore C.W.J.C.No.14907 of 2005, which stood dismissed long back on 18.09.2007 due to non-prosecution.

Since the writ petition stood dismissed long back on 18.09.2007 due to non-prosecution, there is no reason to entertain either Interlocutory Application or restoration petition. Same stands dismissed.
