ORAL ORDER

8 20-12-2017 Having heard learned counsel for the parties and on petitioner's own showing, the entire amount payable to the petitioner have been paid. Since direction issued was for payment. As far as statutory interest is concerned, nothing is pointed out, vis.-a-vis. any statutory interest is payable to the appellant for payment towards leave encashment.

That being so, no further indulgence into the mater is called for. In case the petitioner feels that on account of late settlement of pensionary claims of the petitioner, the petitioner is entitled to



interest on commercial rate of the bank rate interest, the petitioner may initiate proceeding in accordance with law.

Thus this application is disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
