4 13-04-2017 From plain reading of record, it seems that there is dispute between Madarsa, being run by the petitioner, and one, being run by respondent no. 7. The petitioner says that the Madarsa, being run by him, is the genuine Madarsa and is entitled for government aid, which is wrongly being given to the Madarsa, being run by respondent no. 7.



There are disputed questions of facts, which cannot be adjudicated in writ proceeding. Such questions can be raised only in appropriately framed suit in the court of competent jurisdiction.

This application is, accordingly, dismissed.
