5 17-04-2017 Heard learned Counsel for the parties concerned.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Bihar Nurses Registration Council states, on the basis of



instructions received, that the examination fees and forms of the students of Magadh A. N. M. Training School, Kautilya Nagar, Patna, for A. N. M. course, for the sessions 2015-16, shall be accepted. He states that by 19th April, 2017, the students of the said School can submit their examination fees and forms and if they do so, they shall be allowed to appear in the said examination.

In view of the stand taken on behalf of the respondent nos. 4 to 6, this application stands disposed of with the direction to them to receive the examination fees and forms of the students of Magadh A.N.M. Training School, Kautilya Nagar, Patna, for A. N. M. Examination 2015-16 by 19th April, 2017, and if they do so, they shall be allowed to appear in the examination.
