Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and State.

2. After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that despite there being order in their favour, the authorities are not permitting them to join. He submitted that the writ



petition be disposed off with liberty to file a representation before the respondent no. 6, who may be directed to consider the same and pass appropriate orders.

5. If such representation is filed before the respondent no. 6 within four weeks from today, he shall consider and dispose off the same on merits by passing a reasoned order within four weeks thereafter.
