Keeping in view the dispute in question, we direct respondent No. 2, the Collector, West Champaran at Bettiah to look into the grievance of the petitioner and in case orders have been passed for removal of encroachment, to implement the same, in accordance with law. However, we clarify that we have not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case. The Collector is directed to issue notice to the respondent No. 6, before taking any action and merely because we have directed him to look into the matter, he shall



not proceed without granting opportunity of hearing to the respondent
No. 6. The Collector, West Champaran at Bettiah is expected to take
action within a period of three months.
