Before parting with this case, it would be relevant to

note that the order taking cognizance in the present case was

passed as far back as on 18.01.2006, the Court has been informed

that the case is still pending at the same stage. It is difficult to

understand as to why even during this 11 years of the period the



court below has not proceeded with the case. The quashing application in this Court was filed in the year 2014 for setting aside the revisional order dated 26.04.2010. It shows that on the one hand, the petitioner has been moving the Court as and when he desires even after a long lapse of time and at the same time the court below is keeping the matter pending for no reason.

In the circumstances, in the interest of justice, it is directed that the court below must proceed with the matter and conclude this case by taking it to a logical end within a period of six months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
