The issue relates to payment of arrear of salary of the petitioner from the date of his dismissal on 24.02.2005 and the current salary together with interest.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the respondent-Magadh Central Co-operative Bank Ltd. Gaya, being a co-operative society the writ application is not maintainable in view of the ratio laid down in the case of *The Organizer, Dehri C.D. and C.M. Union Limited Vs. The State of Bihar and Ors.* reported as 2014(1) PLJR 695.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the claim of the petitioner is prior to 2014, hence the writ application is maintainable.

This Court finds substances in the submission of counsel for the respondents. Accordingly, the writ application is



dismissed as not maintainable with a liberty to the petitioner to avail alternate remedy available.
