The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court alleging therein that Transmission Line from Barauni Thermal Power Station to G.S.S. Hajipur is not being completed according to the Contract and that an enquiry should be conducted.



We find that whether the contractual terms have been followed or not is to be examined by the agency who has granted contract.

We do not find that any fishing enquiry can be permitted at the instance of a busy body in a public interest litigation. Accordingly, the writ application stands dismissed.
