Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. Learned counsel for the State is present and submitted that supplementary affidavit has been filed on behalf of the State in which it has been stated that the Principal Secretary of the Departments of Revenue and Land Reforms and Finance have sorted out the matter and the benefit has been passed to the writ
