This matter was disposed of on merits by a draft order dictated in open Court on 23.8.2017 but before the order could be finalized that Mr. Sarvadeo Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner, made a motion praying for disposal of the writ petition in the light of the statement made in paragraph 8 of the supplementary counter affidavit filed on behalf of the Addl. Director, Health Department, in which it is stated that the departmental proceeding pending against the petitioner is in advance stage and the final order would be passed within eight weeks in accordance with law.

Director to act upon his undertaking made in paragraph 8 of the supplementary counter affidavit filed on 23.8.2017 to conclude the departmental proceeding within eight weeks of receipt/ production of a copy of this order, in accordance with law.
