2. This application, under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is directed against the order dated 13.11.2014 passed in Trial No. 1674 of 2012 arising out of Majorganj P.S. Case No. 89 of 2012, whereby the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sitamarhi, framed the charge, under Section 363 of the Indian Penal Code, against the accused-petitioners on perusal of the case diary and the materials available on record.

the court for interference in inherent jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
