Inter alia claiming refund of Rs.1,16,630/- and
Rs.54,880/- deposited by the petitioner on various dates, so also a
sum of Rs.61,750/- to the Excise Department at Lakhisarai for
grant of Excise contract and seeking refund of the amount the writ
petition has been filed.

Respondents have filed a counter affidavit and in
para 4 of the same they say that on account of want of necessary
documents, as called for, the claim of the petitioner has not been
settled.



For the present, without entering into the controversy on merit, we direct that on the petitioner filing an application seeking refund of the amount along with necessary documents, the competent authority shall consider and decide the question of refund in accordance with law within sixty days of presentation of the application along with a copy of this order.

With the aforesaid liberty, this application is disposed of.
