ORAL ORDER

3 17-10-2017 The show cause has been filed by respondent No. 2 indicating as to how and in what manner the claim has been settled and why Provident Fund dues could not be granted for certain period.

Keeping in view the show cause filed by the respondent No. 2, it is not a fit case where action for contempt can be initiated.

Accordingly the application is disposed of.
However, if the petitioner has any grievance still subsisting with



regard to the manner in which his claim has been settled, he is granted liberty to assail the same, in accordance with law.
